**1. Report on the Programmes Organized by Regional Coordinating GRI - RCI**

**1.1. Online Interaction Programme**

The GRI - RCI organized Online Interaction Programme on Proposal Development for Community Engagement by UBA Participating Institutions (PIs) in Southern Tamil Nadu in association with National Institute of Rural Development and Panchati Raj, Hyderabad.
