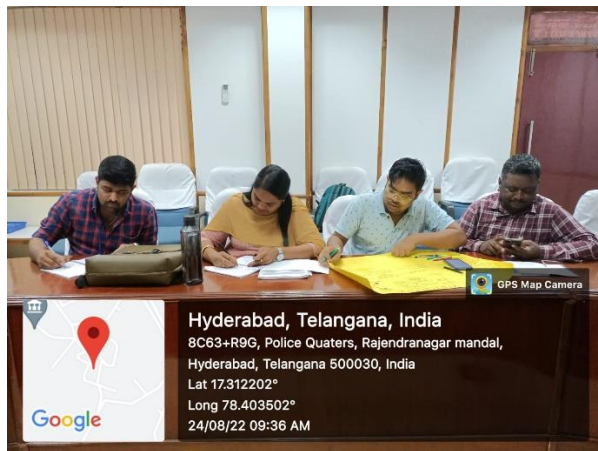


Training Programme in NIRDPR, Hyderabad

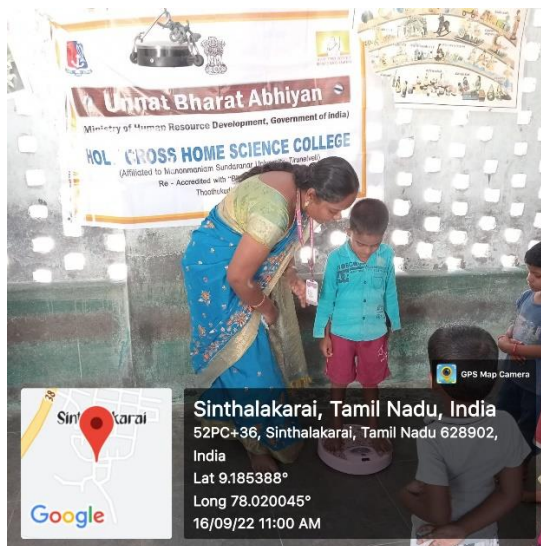
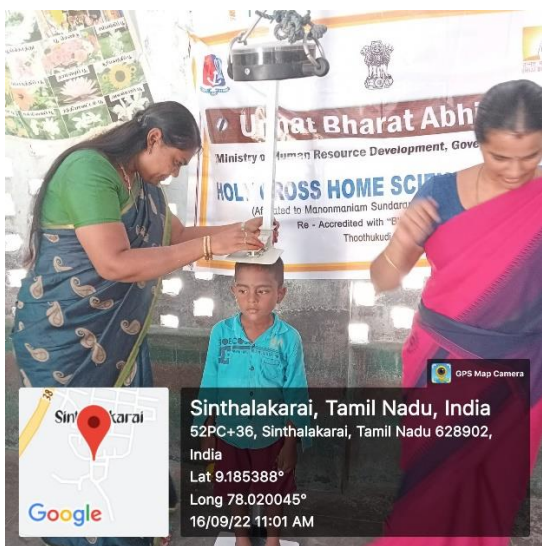


POSHAN Abhiyaan Project – Anganvadi Visit

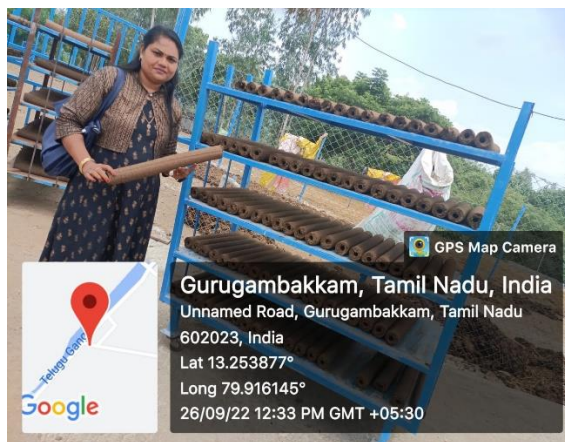


Training Programme on By-Products Using Cow Dung

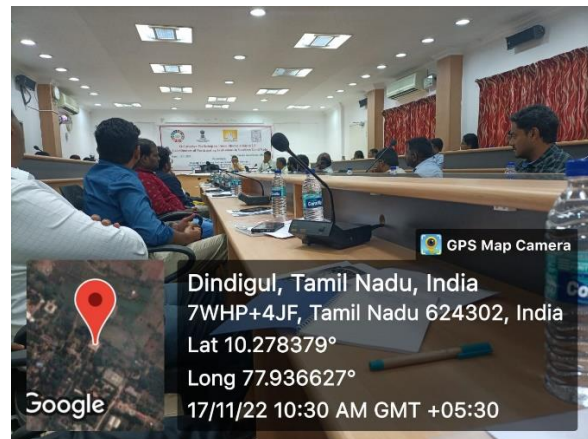

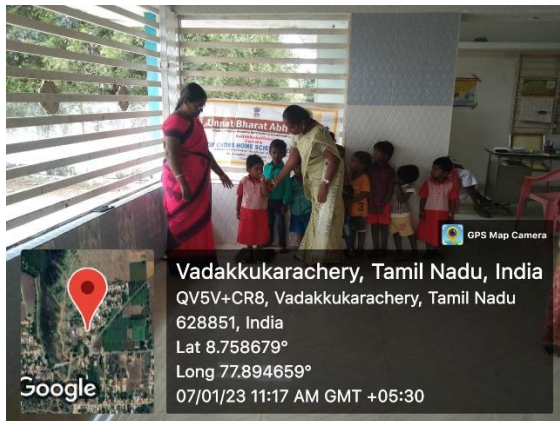

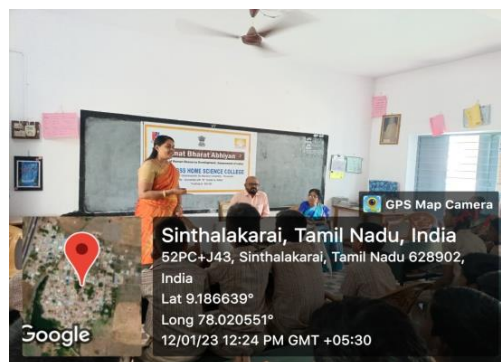


Children's Parliament In Panchayat Union Middle School, Sinthalakkarai.

Income Generation Through Value Added Products Using Cow Dung

2nd February 2023

In order to ensure income generation through skill training, entrepreneurship and employment (**Theme 1**), UBA team of our institution took a survey on common available resources of the villages to bring out entrepreneurs with zero investment in raw materials. UBA team analyzed and found that cow dung and corn husk were the common resource available in Sinthalakarai (adopted village). It was discussed to give skill training on value added products using cow dung to create employability in the village. Cow dung was chosen because of its simple processing methods and it is a zero-investment product.

As an initiative Dr.N.N.Krishna Veni, UBA co-ordinator attended one day training on making value added products using cow dung in Sri Gokula Krishna Kosalaiya, Thiruvallur on 26th September 2022. Training was given in making of Cup Sambrani, Cumputer Sambrani, Mosquito Repellent Stick and Diya Lamp using cow dung. The same training was given to the UBA volunteers of our institution on 28th September 2022 in our college premises.

A team of 5 students and 2 staff was formed for the production of value-added products using cow dung. They collected all the raw materials from the village Sinthalakari (adopted village) and started processing on it. Initially they made mosquito repellent stick using cow dung and few herbal leaves. It was tested by the UBA team for its effectiveness and it worked well. The sample of mosquito repellent stick was distributed to the self-help group members of the village and to the faculties of our college on 2nd February 2023. Our Principal Rev.Dr.Sr.Rubha, our Vice Principal Mrs.C.Sathyalakshmi and UBA Coordinator Dr.N.N.Krishnaveni distributed the samples.

UBA Coordinator requested the self-help group members to distribute the mosquito repellent stick to the village people and know their interest on doing the same as a startup. It was informed to the self-help members that our UBA team will train the interested people and also help them in promotion too.

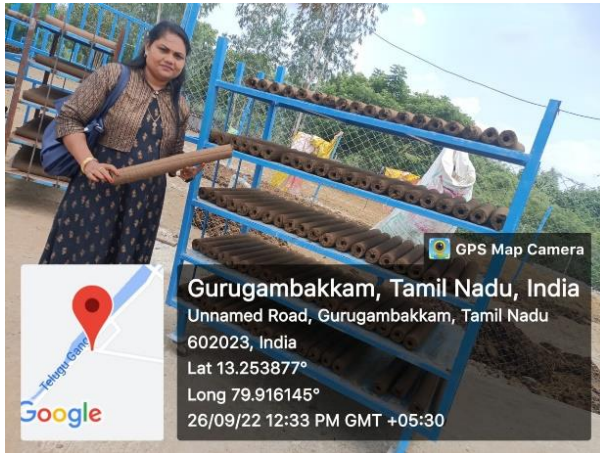

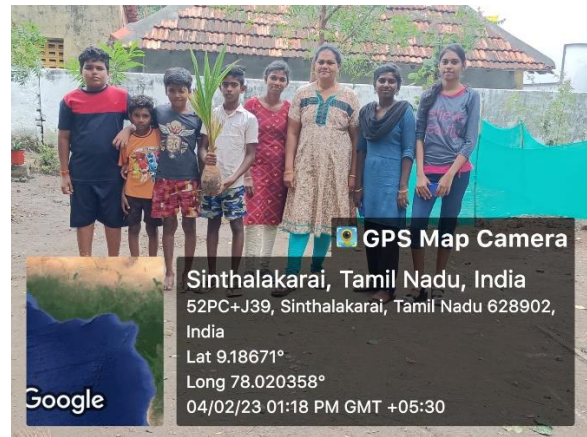
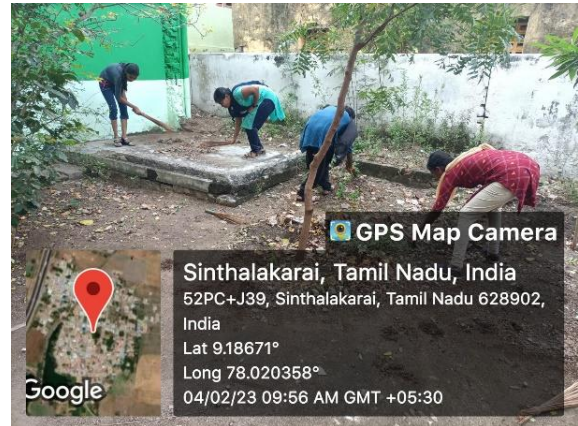
