AWARENESS PROGRAMME ON SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT SCHEMES

NATIVE BREED TREE SAPLING AND PALMYRA PLANTATION ON THE LAKE BUNDS

Sacred Heart College in collaboration with Unnat Bharat Abhiyan conducted an awareness programme on Sustainable Development Schemes in kethandapatti on 18.07.2023. On Tamil Nadu day, the village Panchayat embarked on a commendable initiative to promote environmental conservation and beautification of the lake bunds. They distributed 100 native tree saplings and 300 palmyra seeds to kickstart tree plantation efforts. The dedicated female students played a crucial role by digging planting pits and ensuring the proper planting of saplings, followed by diligent watering and soil tightening to facilitate healthy growth. Protective fencing using thorny sticks was erected to shield the plants from potential harm. Meanwhile, the boys contributed by digging pits for the seeding of 300 palmyra seeds along the foreshore of Kethandapatti Lake bunds. This collaborative effort also saw the participation of MGNREGA workers, enhancing the success of this eco-friendly endeavor and underscoring the importance of community involvement in environmental conservation. The outcome of these activities was Students understood pragmatically the difficulty in planting trees and seeding of palmyra on the lake bunds, understood socialization with villagers, and worked as a team.



<u>COLLECTION OF PALMYRA FRUITS FOR SEEDING IN THE LAKE BUNDS OF</u> <u>TIRUPATTUR</u>

As part of the college's green initiatives, students actively engaged in the collection of palmyra fruits, demonstrating their commitment to sustainability and community involvement. Guided by village panchayat members, both girls and boys enthusiastically gathered palmyra fruits from various parts of the village. These fruits were meticulously packed into 50kg sacks, with each sack containing approximately 80-100 fruits. Throughout the day, the collective efforts of the students resulted in the collection of an impressive 30 sacks of palmyra fruits, which were then transported to the college in a Tata Ace goods carrier. In addition to their hands-on participation in this green initiative, the students took the opportunity to engage with the villagers in meaningful discussions after lunch. These interactions allowed them to gain valuable insights into the village's traditions, customs, employment opportunities, educational facilities, water sources, crops cultivated, and the local flora and fauna. This exchange of knowledge and experiences fostered a deeper connection between the college and the community, promoting a spirit of mutual learning and collaboration in their pursuit of sustainable practices. To promote ecological sustainability, approximately 1000 palm seeds were planted in the village, while 30 plant saplings were introduced in both the school and the village, emphasizing the significance of afforestation and green spaces in promoting a healthier environment.
