**Extension Activities through Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA)** 



During the Academic Session 2021-22, the University conducted many activities within the campus as well as off-campus related to Education, Medical, Agriculture fields along with various public & legal awareness programmes.

The University is providing medical facilities to the community through its teaching hospitals. The University has three hospitals, 6 Village Development Centres, 8 PHCs & the 5 adopted villages (Jharna, Devla, Keshrisinghpura, Kapidyawas and Kotjewar) through MHRD rural development project of UBA.


#### > "Pushya Nakshtra Community Health Program" (PCHP-2021)

"Pushya Nakshtra Community Health Program" (PCHP-2021) was organized by the AYUSH internees of BAMS, BHMS & BNYS programs. This program will be conducted from January 1, 2021, to September 4, 2021 (on 10 Pushya Nakshatras of the year) with the team of University interns and doctors from University hospitals to stimulate the child and adults health growth by increasing their vital force to fight any kind of infection.









Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University, Jaipur created history on 21.01.2021 and became the first University in the country to get its name officially recorded in the India Book of Records for sponsoring the record event 'Maximum Ayush Medicines Administered in an hour by Female Interns' under Community Development Activities (CDA) as 'Pushya Nakshtra Community Health Program (PNCHP)' to fulfil university mission 'Education for Community Development Leading to Women Empowerment' on January 1, 2021, wherein 87 female interns administered AYUSH medicines (Homeopathic and Ayurvedic) to kids and adults in 10 villages across Rajasthan. The Award conferred by Dr. Vinod Singh is Adjudicator at India Book of Records & Asia Book of Records & Smita Singh is Adjudicator at India Book of Records & Asia Book of Records. to Jayoti Vidyapeeth Women's University during Award & Felicitation Ceremony on 21.1.2021 at JVWU Premises.

#### **Education Mentorship:**
