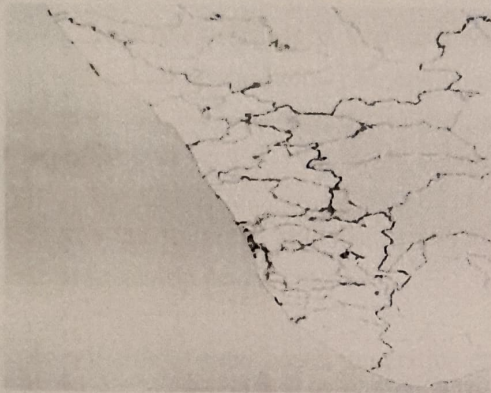


PIDAVOOR GRAMA PANCHAYAT DEVELOPMENT PLAN
